How will we know our solution is working (measurement plan)

2-3 minutes

- **Increase in student attendance**
Decrease in chronic absenteeism - an absence is a child's vote
- **Increase in teacher retention**
Using classroom as recruitment tool for future teachers
- **Increase in student stakeholder**
Survey participation/Engagement in decisionmaking spaces
- **Tangible portfolio of student work**
Students can show skills in addition to academic achievement/test scores-demonstrable soft skills

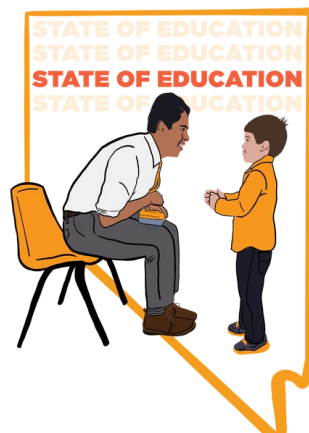
